MARKET CROSS

Scheduled monument consent has been obtained and a contractor appointed to commence the project to survey and carry out preservation works on The Cross. For these works scaffolding will be erected around The Cross and it may be necessary to close the pavement during the works. To minimise inconvenience to pedestrians it is intended to carry out the works during the school summer holiday.

FROM THE STALBRIDGE ARCHIVE GROUP

The Archive group are still busily cataloguing our ever-growing collection of historical photographs and documents. We are also preparing a small display for the Hub Open Morning on 7th April. This display is about William Lovelace who opened a garage in 1911 making bicycles. He also had a charabanc service offering trips to Weymouth and Cheddar. After the Second World War, the Lovelace bus business was bought by Patrick Lewis having returned from serving in the Canadian Airforce. With more modern buses Pat



continued to provide trips, he also ran the school bus service to Sturminster Newton which many will still remember.
